

Appendix A: The 2020 Election And Its Connection To The 2024 Election / Future

No meaningful statement about the 2024 presidential election (or any significant election in America) can be complete without a reference to the disaster of the 2020 presidential election, because the 2024 election is directly linked to the 2020 election, and is an opportunity for justice to prevail.

There is perhaps no greater example of the devastating effects of the combination of fear, corruption, lack of wisdom, and dereliction of duty according to the spirit of American leadership than that which was displayed following the 2020 presidential election, in the utter failure to ensure that the results of that election were true. And there is no greater need, as it relates to the consequences of the election, than for those who have failed to fully investigate and report on the truth to do so now.

It was expected that the usual suspects involved in destroying our country would cover up what happened in the 2020 election. But when so many Republicans, honest Democrats, conservative media, and others who are allied with America and trusted to protect our country and report on the truth, failed to do just that by totally neglecting to expose the total spectrum of malfeasance and fraud clearly involved in the election, they did a horrendous and incalculable disservice to the American people and the country, the devastating effects of which we have been experiencing from that time to this very hour. All who failed the country in 2020 need to redeem themselves now in 2024. Therefore, the question must be asked: why should those who failed the country with protecting and reporting on any and all malfeasance in 2020 – especially the major media outlets - be trusted by the American people with the 2024 presidential election?

They not only failed to aggressively investigate, expose, and report on the fraud and the innumerable problems with the election during the critical time immediately following it, but have now gone (for the most part) completely silent on the matter for nearly four years. Of course, this does not include the five state hearings (which were truly outstanding and revealing), or a number of House and Senate Republicans who did indeed stand up in real time.

Moreover, Republicans and the conservative media have never given their constituents a reason for their silence on a matter so incredibly critical to the country. It is unconscionable that they have not leveled with the American people as to why they did not, and continue to not, show up in this vital battle. Such silence would normally indicate that they don't believe the obvious truth of election fraud, or don't care enough about the country or the people to report on it – both of which would ultimately disqualify them from being forces of truth. However, the larger reality appears to be that many good leaders and media members got overwhelmed and intimidated by the threat of lawsuits, etc., and did not act in their normal capacity. We can only hope that they may still come around and save their honor in this particular battle

This silence has essentially legitimized the lawlessness of the election. It has allowed the Democrats and media to take complete and total control over the narrative of the election by which they have created a total false reality about it (and January 6th), and have continuously bludgeoned the people and our nation with fabrication after fabrication (and held multiple absurd hearings) without, for the most part, the slightest resistance from the Republicans or conservative media. It has emboldened them to extend their attacks on Trump, Republicans, and millions of informed Americans, while strengthening that lie that the election was pure and legitimate.

The horrendous consequence of this silence can be witnessed by the boldness of the Democrats and their surrogates now going to the outer extremes of gaslighting the country by literally charging President Trump with the very thing they are guilty of - attempting to overturn the results of an election. All of this has served to tighten the stranglehold of power that was wrongfully gained, and made it more difficult to speak out on future cheating or malfeasance – which is sure to happen.

The strategy not to expose the fraud at all, but rather to bury it and simply wait for the next election has backfired massively. It has 1) encouraged cheating in future elections, 2) allowed four years of deep damage to be done to the country, 3) made what should be easily the greatest midterm sweep in American history by far, (both in numbers of victories and in the margins of those victories) closer than it ever should be, 4) empowered Democrats and the mainstream media to lie about the elections with impunity – which added to the midterm candidates (and to the Republican Party) the enormous burden of contending with the lie that the election was fair and free, and 5) opened millions of courageous Americans who spoke out (and are speaking out) about the election to suspicion and persecution, leaving them without cover from those whose job it is to cover them.

Instead of directing the attention of the American people to the central truth about the election, Republican politicians and conservative media have all but evaded that central truth, and instead focused endlessly on the effects of the rigged election without calling out the actual rigging itself. This is to forever chase the wind because it follows the same dysfunctional pattern of reacting to symptoms of a problem without ever getting to the cause of the problem - guaranteeing that that problem will continue unendingly until the root cause is addressed.

To detail the ever-present egregious events of the current administration without pointing out that this administration would never have gained power to create these events, but for a fraudulent election, is to be dishonest and disingenuous with the people. The integrity and solicitude of our election process can never be compromised for political purposes. Regardless of what one thinks about Trump, the reality is that if he were the president, we wouldn't be going through most of what we are going through, and many major crises would have been avoided.

The, as of now, conscious decision to not correctly address the clear rigging, fraud, irregularities, unconstitutional law changes, and so much more of the easily demonstrable malfeasance and chaos clearly associated with the 2020 presidential election will go down as one of the greatest, if not the greatest, moral, political, and strategic mistakes and failings in American history. But even now, there is still the opportunity to do the right thing and bring the truth to light.

For America can survive a rigged election (and a wrongful outcome), but it cannot survive lying about, covering up, or endlessly pretending that the rigging never happened. It can survive only if the truth is told to the American people, because at least the people would have a correct perspective of why we are experiencing so many of the bizarre crisis that we are experiencing, and there would be one less contributing factor to the massive divide in our country. From this knowledge, accurate steps to ensure that this never happens again can be taken with the enlightened consent of the majority of people. But it cannot survive (as in thrive again) if the truth is covered up, because then the root condition remains in place only to manifest again, whether in the exact same form or in a different form.

In summary, while we can say that Joe Biden was legitimately made president (because our system allowed the illegitimacies of the election to be ignore), we cannot say that he got there through the free and fair means expected by the American people - and therefore, there must be reconciliation with this reality.

The idea that he got eighty-one million entirely legitimate votes according to the highest standards of election integrity expected by the American people is ludicrous on its face. Not only do the American people deserve to know the whole truth about the 2020 presidential election (as well as January 6th), it is essential to the life and health of the country that the whole truth comes out. Appendix A Part 2: Election Letters to the Supreme Court and Republican Leaders

(These letters were written in real time and provide further insight into the consequences of the 2020 election)

April 5, 2022

Dear Justices of the Supreme Court:

I am writing to you (and each supreme court justice) on three vitally important interrelated topics upon which the balance of our future as a nation and a people hang:

1. The critical need to finally address the fraud, malfeasance, and rigging associated with the 2020 US Presidential Election.
2. The protection of personal health and medical freedom in relation to Covid-19 mandates and especially mandated vaccinations – which is addressed as a separate statement and included with this letter.
3. The protection of first amendment rights.

I am also writing to encourage and support you in your crucial service to our country.

In this packet you will find 3 separate letters including: this current letter regarding the presidential election of 2020; a letter that I wrote to members of the US Senate dated February 8, 2021 (as a matter of reference); and a statement on Covid-19 mandates.

Overview:

By far and away, the greatest overall existential threat to our democracy is the unchecked tyranny that is now threatening everything from our elections to our first amendment rights, to our very ability to exist in society without proof of Covid-19 vaccination and other abusive mandates. Therefore, each Supreme Court Judge's legacy will be determined exactly by how they ruled against the rampant tyranny, fraud, suppression of the 1st Amendment, and injustice in their day.

The Presidential Election of 2020

“There was in a certain city a judge who did not fear God nor regard man. Now there was a widow in that city; and she came to him, saying, ‘Get justice for me from my adversary.’ And he would not for a while; but afterward he said within himself, ‘Though I do not fear God nor regard man, yet because this widow troubles me I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me.’”

Then the Lord said, “Hear what the unjust judge said. And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them? I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?” –Luke 18:2-8

Background:

I've watched the persistent degradation and destruction of our country, our way of life, and our entire value system now for three decades by the same forces whose philosophy and means are openly antithetical to everything that our nation was founded upon. Things have gotten so progressively worse, especially in the last decade, that we have seen what can only be described as evil influences attempting to take down and take over our great nation.

So important is our country, the office of the presidency, and the need for quality leadership, that I created a website called strengthenation.com which outlines those critical areas, exhorts people of faith to pray and fast for the overall welfare of our nation and the rightful outcome of the election, and provides a whole range of valuable information on our nation's greatest needs.

Trump's Presidency and the Election:

Instead of competing against President Trump by developing a better America First platform and candidate base than he and the republicans had, democrats and others circumvented this natural competitive process and used nefarious methods to attempt to gain power. I, along with tens of millions of Americans, witnessed Donald Trump's presidency be treacherously undermined at every turn from the very start in ways unparalleled in American history. We observed early in the summer of 2020 the Covid-19 pandemic becoming a political weapon angled toward the presidential election in the fall, as election laws were subsequently brazenly and illegally changed in multiple swing states to allow for a massive mail-in ballot campaign. This unauthorized changing of protective laws essentially guaranteed the impossibility of a true and accurate election.

We then watched in stunned silence as the presidential election appeared to be stolen right before our very eyes on the night of November 3rd, and in the days and weeks that followed. When after the progression of constitutional steps failed to address the obvious problems and lawlessness with the election, we hoped that the Supreme Court would step in and effect justice. When the court failed to do this, dismay, anger, and frustration replaced hope – yet even still now, the truth remains and so does God's ultimate justice.

Where We Stand:

Every day that now passes reveals just how inestimably destructive it was to have essentially surrendered the 2020 presidential election to the forces that rigged it. From the insane crisis at the southern border (which in effect is the purposeful opening of our borders resulting in a floodgate of several millions of illegal aliens, drugs, and assorted bad actors to pour into the country); to the unconstitutional, unscientific push for compulsory vaccination upon threat; to the inexplicable Taliban takeover of Afghanistan; to critical regions in the world being destabilized; to being brought to the brink of World War III; to the almost total loss of trust in our intelligence agencies on the part of tens of millions of Americans; to the aggressive suppression of free speech; to the breakdown of virtually every indicator of law and order in our cities; to mass inflation across the board; to the obscene gas prices; to the severe supply chain disruption; to the entirely out of control spending and increase of our national debt by billions and trillions; to the media's increasing corruption and gas lighting of the American people; to the attempted dismantling of our voting and governance systems; to the continual moral decline; to an individual being nominated to the Supreme Court who wouldn't define what a woman is; and so much more – it is now clear that our nation is quickly spiraling out of all control. It is now impossible to deny that the country is dramatically worse off holistically in ways that can scarcely be comprehended than it was just over a year ago – as the seeds of our total destruction and

demise are being planted ever deeper economically, socially, morally, and politically by the day. Even the Supreme Court's very own survival is threatened by the lawlessness of the stated agenda to add judges to the Court, and thereby destroying the legitimacy of it.

Essential Questions That Future Generations Will Ask Surrounding the 2020 Presidential Election:

Once history has allowed for its lucid perspective to be gained on the 2020 presidential election and the subsequent comprehensive dismantling of our nation, future generations and historians are sure to ask themselves the same astonishing and bewildering questions that millions of Americans are asking themselves today:

1. How is it possible that the greatest nation on earth allowed its greatest election to be stolen?
2. How could any knowledgeable, honest or reasonable person in a position of authority, trust, and responsibility in the state or federal government, judicial system, or media possibly have gone along with the demonstratively false narrative of "no proof of election fraud" – which presupposes that the election was executed according to all standards of ethical and procedural integrity – when even a cursory review of the circumstantial and direct evidence makes it abundantly and obviously clear that the exact opposite was true, and that in fact there was an astonishing span of malfeasance that is easily verifiable?
3. How could a nation that works toward protecting the free and fair elections of some of the most corrupt nations on earth have failed to ensure that its own most important election was free and fair?
4. How is it possible that not one state or federal court actually held a functional hearing that allowed the abundance of evidence across multiple fields to be evaluated in real time?
5. How is it possible that key swing states allowed their election laws to be altered unconstitutionally just prior to the election in ways that guaranteed an insecure election, and assured that fraud would most certainly be committed?
6. How is it possible that more evidence of election malfeasance became quickly available than could even be readily reviewed, and yet went ignored by the media and our various oversight and intelligence agencies? This evidence includes, but is not limited to: dozens of hours of critical and compelling eye witness testimony, well over 1000 verifiable affidavits (not to mention thousands of more Americans who could also have testified of malfeasance), and damning videos of blatant election misconduct that were all presented in over six hearings in the key swing states.
7. How is it possible that not a single comprehensive functional investigation was launched into the total spectrum of election malfeasance of the 2020 presidential election? And for that matter, how was it possible that Mike Lindell, Dinesh D'Souza, and other private citizens were able to gather enormous amounts of evidence and present a far greater case to the American people than did the very institutions and agencies that were put in place to do that very thing?
8. How is it possible that a full investigation of the presidential election could have continued to have gone uninitiated for months (and to this very day) in the face of the obvious reality that if Donald Trump were the rightful president, the mounting daily catastrophes that we all clearly witnessed would not have occurred.

9. How is it possible that events of the Capital riot – a singular episode which lasted a few hours – received one hundred times more condemnation and attention from democratic leaders and the media than did the hundreds of riots of BLM/Antifa which lasted days, weeks, and months, and were astronomically more serious in every measure of destruction?
10. How could there have been such an obsession with January 6th on the part of certain lawmakers and the media, and such indifference to November 3rd, when in fact it was the egregiousness of the election that set the stage for the events of January 6th to have occurred in the first place? In other words, how could there possibly be a January 6th committee but not a November 3rd committee?
11. How is it possible that there could be political prisoners in America – how could such horrible, abusive, and totally unconstitutional treatment of certain January 6th protesters been allowed to happen on American soil?
12. How is it possible that every single oversight measure that was put into place through the wisdom of the constitution failed to achieve their purpose at every turn, and therefore enabled an election that was rife with malfeasance to produce the fraudulent results that were allowed to stand?
13. How is it possible that the Supreme Court, the highest court in the land, essentially made itself of no avail in ruling against the greatest political corruption scheme in American history – viz the 2020 presidential election?
14. How is it possible that we had the means to settle at least one aspect of the question of election malfeasance through forensic audits, which should have appealed to every honest and forthright person, yet these audits were met with the strongest opposition conceivable by those who claim that the election was the most secure in the history of our nation?
15. How did so few leaders in government, the private sector, and the media not have the will, courage, wisdom, and foresight to demand answers as to what really happened in the 2020 presidential election?
16. How is it possible that half the country allowed itself to be totally and utterly deceived for 3 years by the Russia collusion hoax – which represented the most elaborate, criminally corrupt political scheme against a president in American history – and then continue to trust the very same sources who deceived them to tell the truth about the 2020 Presidential election?
17. How is it possible that all the supposed bright and good leaders on both sides of the aisle could have calculated that it would end well for the country to allow a presidential election that was permeated with (at the very least) the appearance of rampant fraud and malfeasance to go undealt with?
18. How is it possible that the American people allowed big tech and the mainstream media to have interfered with any election, let alone the presidential election?
19. How is it possible that certain critical information and key reports (such as Hunter Biden’s laptop) – which would have definitively impacted the vote – were denied or removed from the public forum?
20. Finally, how is it possible that the greatest nation in the history of the world, which prides itself on “truth, justice, and the American way”, allowed its presidential election to be rigged, defrauded, and abjectly stolen while allowing that rigging to remain continuously unaddressed at the highest level?
21. How is it possible that leaders on both sides of the aisle could not see that by allowing election fraud to stand in this election, credibility of all future major elections would be jeopardized?

The Failure of the Election:

As far as ensuring a truly fair election, with the exception of a few brave and heroic leaders throughout the state and federal government and judicial systems, our entire system and process of checks and balances and ethical and loyal governance failed in an unprecedented way.

Nature of the Failure:

It's not that evidence of election fraud and malfeasance is not there in abundance, it's that there was (and is) a concentrated unwillingness to look at that abundance of evidence that is clearly there. The nature of the failure to address and expose the rigging and fraud of the 2020 presidential election centered on simply denying and avoiding the whole issue of malfeasance however, whenever, and in whatsoever way possible.

Every entity of government, including the Supreme Court (with notable individual exception), avoided its sacred duty and responsibility by actively seeking some plausible way out – some loophole, some excuse, and some reason not to deal head on with what was obviously right before them, and which constituted one of the greatest undermining actions against our democracy in American history. By neglecting to fight the first great battle that was before them in real time, leaders ensured that they and America would be fighting a thousand unnecessary battles in the time to come.

The Reason for the Failure:

Only in the absence of enough strong leaders with that extra level of real courage, wisdom, conviction, moral centering, and strength from God could an election have been stolen right in front of the eyes of the American people and those of the entire world. As Edmund Burke said “The only thing necessary for the triumph of evil is for good men to do nothing”.

The unfathomable brazen rigging of a presidential election placed tremendous stress and strain on the entire country, severely tested every leader (those both good and bad), and paralyzed many into inactivity and denial. Therefore, the reasons for the failure to take on the whole issue of election fraud and malfeasance were many and varied: on the one hand, there was fear, intimidation, confusion, ignorance, etc... and on the other hand, there was corruption, compromise, and complicity; and a lack of will, patriotism, and commitment.

Essentially, these reasons center on the reality that confronting a potential stealing of an election was just too overwhelming in the moment for the ordinary leader. So many good people were simply overmatched, outplayed, thrown, and uninformed as to the evidence, and as such, turned away from evaluating and investigating the evidence. They thereby caved into submission and acceptance of something so blatantly wrong on the most basic level of democracy. Ironically, had the total spectrum of malfeasance and fraud been lesser, the ease of dealing with them would have been greater.

What Happened vs. What Should Have Happened:

Instead of seeking what was truly right for the long-term good of this country and really getting to the truth of what happened in the 2020 presidential election, and then dealing with it in a manner that would have been worthy of a great nation, it is clear that the majority of individuals in leadership did not want to be involved with what was perceived to be too difficult and too daunting a responsibility, and one that had too much of a political price to pay.

Whether they really did not know the whole truth about what really happened in the election, or suspected what happened but didn't want to know, they acted against their own enlightened self-interests by choosing a false form of self-preservation over a true form of preserving the country – which is a miscalculation whose outcome guarantees its opposite objective, as the fall of the country guarantees the same fall of those who were supposed to be guarding it.

The result is that, at a time when the country needed key leaders to step up, those leaders stepped down; when they needed to be strong they became weak; when they needed to be courageous they became docile; and when they needed to be giants they became small. Despite this, I believe that every leader that came up short can now regain their rightful position and will have the opportunity to do so.

The Consequence of the Failure:

In short, when the presidential election was given away, so was a part of our country given away. In this evasion of responsibility, many leaders acted shortsightedly both for the nation and themselves, as their own families and posterity may well now suffer severe consequences for generations to come if this failure is not addressed and if there is not an overwhelming correction to the negative results of an administration that did not rightfully win the election. To think that the country would be better served by allowing the potential stealing of an election to go unaddressed was a severe miscalculation on the part of those leaders who were placed in positions to oversee election integrity.

For if one believes that a presidential election can be entirely undermined and yet the country can somehow return to normal without correcting that undermining, history emphatically tells us differently. And if one thinks that confronting election fraud is difficult and disruptive to the country, failing to confront that fraud and allowing it to stand is to sacrifice the entire nation to that fraud with the blind, non-existent chance that the consequences of doing so will somehow be less than the “consequences” of exposing and resisting that fraud.

Understandably, it was fear and intimidation driven into the minds of leaders that determined their inaction. But every lesson of history and every understanding of human nature and the course of human events teach us that appeasement, passivity, and apathy in dealing with the advance of some form of growing evil and injustice against a people or a country ends in disaster, and proves to be many times more problematic and disruptive to the people and to that nation than could even have initially be imagined – even to the point of potential severe subjugation, civil disunion, or annihilation.

The Supreme Court's Failure:

When the Supreme Court fails to enact justice either by commission or omission in some essential area, the consequences are devastating. For example, in 2015 when the Court took on the case for gay marriage, it arrived at its decision without following any law or precedent whatsoever. In the process, it entirely ignored what the Scriptures clearly say about God's moral order and plan for marriage – representing the first time the Supreme Court went directly against the Scriptures in a settled matter of morality, and in the process, literally changed an absolute and definitive definition. That decision opened wide the door for the chaos of “transgender rights”, which essentially has translated into the demand to change fundamental words in our language, for girls and women to be displaced by males having access to their bathrooms, locker-rooms, and sports; and for many other things that are not only unsustainable in society, but also degrading of society. The chaos and degradation is especially acutely felt in our school systems.

The Supreme Court's failure in this past presidential election was particularly harrowing, damaging, and painful. For what hope can this nation have if its highest court – which is the guardian of the constitution and the ultimate ensurer of justice – fails to act in the most critical moment of our greatest election? In fact, by the court failing to act in the presidential election to the degree that the spirit of the constitution demanded of it, the precedent was set that the court could not necessarily be relied upon as a bulwark of justice if the stakes are too high.

When the Supreme Court declined to execute its just authority and operate in the clear sovereignty of its jurisdiction for the American people by repeatedly ignoring the cry to hear cases which would have allowed for the evidence of multiple illegalities and rigging surrounding the election to be submitted, the whole concept of a “supreme” ruling court was all but destroyed and confidence in the Court's objectivity, independence, and ability to be absolute and resolute in effecting justice was diminished to near zero.

This is because the American people's greatest aspiration regarding the Supreme Court is that the Court is truly the one final arbiter of truth and justice, and therefore it will act above and independent of all competing forces in selecting cases, evaluating evidence, applying the law, safeguarding the constitution, and effecting justice when no one else will or even can. When this great mechanism of justice is disabled, the final constitutional safeguard against injustice and tyranny is also disabled, and thereby removed.

Contrary to effecting justice, the Court's lack of strong action all but assured that justice was not afforded to President Trump, the Constitution, or the American people. Furthermore, the Court's pattern of avoidance in denying these court cases has been used as one of the leading “proofs” for the abjectly false and deceptive gas lighting narrative of “no evidence of election fraud” – a narrative that to this very day continues to pervert the truth from being known and prevent justice from being served.

How The Court Will Be Viewed:

As far as the 2020 presidential election specifically, because the court chose to abdicate itself from its major responsibility regarding the election, it unwittingly aligned itself with those individuals, entities, and elements that are destroying this country. And if the court does not reverse its resistant position in this (and other critical matters), it will be viewed through history's lens as one of the major contributing factors of what was the greatest political scandal in American history.

What Needs to Now Happen:

The evidence that the presidential election was rigged, interfered with, and stolen was clear enough in the minds of millions of Americans from the start. And now, with new irrefutable reports and proof that has come out in recent days, weeks, and months, it is all but impossible to deny those early signs and the initial evidence indicating that the election was manipulated. The Supreme Court needs to take a stake in the 2020 presidential election. For the sake of our country, the Court needs to take on the cases that may still come before it regarding the 2020 presidential election, or anything related to truly securing our elections in order to safeguard our nation.

As far as what constitutes the Court's true jurisdiction, it is the whole span of protecting the Constitution of the United States. Ultimately, what promotes the general welfare and supports truth, justice, and freedom is constitutional, and what does not promote these is unconstitutional.

I want you to know that I believe the Supreme Court is an incredible institution, and that to be a member of it is a matter of honor that is unequalled in western civilization – so great and majestic are the responsibilities. I think that almost universally the general public vastly underestimates and underappreciates the true value of a good and wise judge, and the service he or she does to the country.

Our nation is in the throes of a battle for its very survival. The attempt to dismantle America as we know it comes from both internal and external forces, and literally effects everything related to our national life. Because of this, never has the need for the Supreme Court (and each Supreme Court Justice) to perform its role with honor, strength, acuity, and moral integrity been more utterly critical than now.

However, never has the Supreme Court been more politicized then it is now, never has it been called on to settle more cases of sweeping corruption, and therefore never have individual justices been under more intense pressure to do the bidding of those whose agendas have nothing to do with the comprehensive good of the country. And there is no question that it has never been more difficult and challenging to be a leader in any dimension of political or civic life than it is now, which is why the need to draw strength from the Almighty has never been greater.

I encourage you to lay hold of the singular responsibility that you have as a Supreme Court Judge with all your mind and soul – which is to ensure that real justice is effected according to the whole truth, the whole will of God, and for the whole good of America and the American people. This is the fifth time I am writing to Republican Senators (as well as some Democrats) on the critical subject of the 2020 US presidential election and the overall health of our nation. The previous letters were dated November 5th, December 15th (sent to the Homeland Security & Government Affairs Committee), December 30th, and January 15th. I would be happy to provide hard or electronic copies of these, or you can view them at the website “Strengththenation.com”.

Each letter references the website that I created to strengthen the presidency and edify the nation. My motivation in writing to you again on this matter is out of pure concern for the country, and I have enormous respect for the Senate, and fully support its members, regardless of party affiliation. It is horrifying what has happened to this country, especially in the last decade (in terms of the overall breakdown), and it is saddening and sickening that our political leaders have either allowed it to happen or have taken part in what has happened (wittingly or unwittingly). My website strengththenation.com (which is referenced in each of the letters) will demonstrate my clear commitment to encouraging and inspiring a greater America and a stronger leadership base.

25 Summary Points

The central points and themes of my concerns about the 2020 presidential election (as expressed in the other writings) can be summarized in the following points:

- 1) The chaotic events surrounding the 2020 presidential election could only have happened within the greater context of the moral and spiritual crisis that our country has been in the midst of for years.
- 2) The left (as opposed to true Democrats), along with multiple complicit forces, has been demoralizing the American people by destroying our institutions, taking away basic freedoms, ignoring the scriptures on the basics of life, gender, sexuality, and marriage, inventing and weaponizing a whole line up of false narratives, and attacking our way of life progressively for years without any real consequences or enough effective counter measures on the part of our elected officials that we have entrusted to protect our nation.
- 3) The rigging of the 2020 presidential election (and the subsequent failure to deal with that rigging) was a blatant attempt to steal President Trump’s rightfully hard-earned second term, and represented the same malevolent and undermining behavior that was altogether clearly displayed every single day of his first term by many Democrats, media, and other operatives.
- 4) If true, the election fraud crisis of the 2020 presidential election represents both the greatest assault against our republic in its history, and the greatest injustice ever committed against the whole of the American people.
- 5) The election fraud scheme centered on using the pandemic as a guise to make last minute unconstitutional changes to election laws in key swing states, which allowed, in part, millions of ballots to be mailed out and subsequently “returned” without the ability to verify the proper chain of custody, setting the stage for a massive amount of illegal votes to be utilized.
- 6) The total spectrum of alleged law-breaking, malfeasance, irregularities, and fraud was manifested in a wide range of spectacularly corrupt activities that were witnessed by well over one thousand credible affiants and testimonies from a wide range of truth-tellers, whistleblowers, and others, including everyday Americans, poll watchers, UPS and postal drivers, election officials, observers, etc. These eyewitness accounts are entirely devastating to the narrative of the notion that there was no election fraud, as those accounts are so real, credible, and heartfelt that they are impossible to dismiss as anything other than authentic and truthful, and should be counted as such until and unless they are specifically proven otherwise.

7) The narrative of “no evidence of election fraud” is itself a fraud (in effect a fraud within a fraud), and is being used to further gaslight the American people and intimidate and silence anybody who would bring the painful reality of the truth of what really happened in the election to light.

8) The demonizing of those who venture to claim there was election fraud is nothing more than a tactic to distract attention away from where the real wrongdoing lies. Furthermore, this demonization is a severe evil that bears false witness against perfectly innocent and patriotic Americans who are using their common sense, their powers of reason, evaluating straight forward evidence, identifying statistical and data anomalies (if not impossibilities), exercising their absolute and unabridged right to question and freely speak out on political and social matters, defending their voting rights, protecting America according to the entire spirit of our founding and our constitution, and defending the nation against attacks from within and without.

9) The spurious “no evidence of election fraud” false narrative was peddled immediately by the media and the Democrats before there could be any intelligent and rational examination of the bizarre events that took place before, during, and after the night of November 3rd– and especially in the middle of the night. An actual accurate statement regarding election fraud would center on the fact that remarkably and inexplicably there has been no thorough evaluation of the overwhelming credible allegations of election irregularities and fraud by any court, federal body, or mainstream media outlet. In America, legitimate claims of injustice are investigated, and the victim of injustice is given “his day in court” as a primary legal means of defending himself. When this vital principle of American justice is denied, so also is true justice denied, and lawlessness is sanctioned. This is precisely what has happened on a scale unimaginable in the 2020 presidential election. Whether or not one believes that there was significant election fraud, the overwhelming broad-spectrum evidence combined with the gravity of the situation absolutely demanded, at the very least, a true hearing – yet that hearing never happened.

10) The secret of the effectiveness of the false claim of “no election fraud” lies in its absurdity: it is so devoid of reality that human nature is to assume that it is missing something when in fact it is not missing anything. Furthermore, the persistent falsehood perfectly illustrates Joseph Goebbels’ strategy for propaganda:

“If you tell a lie big enough and keep repeating it, people will eventually come to believe it. The lie can be maintained only for such time as the State can shield the people from the political, economic, and/or military consequences of the lie. It thus becomes vitally important for the State to use all of its powers to repress dissent, for the truth is the mortal enemy of the lie, and thus by extension, the truth is the greatest enemy of the State”.

11) Every action that has been taken in mostly democrat-controlled precincts, both in leading up to the election and since, has been to all but guarantee that the election would indeed not be fair, accurate, and protected.

12) What is desperately needed in understanding why there are allegations of wide-spread election malfeasance, and what has thus far been entirely missing, is for one legislative body to investigate the entire sweep, survey, and summary of the massive attempt to undermine, interfere with, defraud, and steal the 2020 election. Every aspect of this attempt needs to be deeply and comprehensively evaluated and viewed in its whole context, rather than in its separate elements.

13) What has happened in the 2020 presidential election has happened, and is happening, on the Senate’s watch. The Senate oath requires that senators defend the nation against enemies, foreign and domestic. Unless each senator (and the Senate as a whole) uses his or her influence to their fullest extent to expose this fraud and reverse its effects, those senators will become part of the problem rather than part of the solution. They will lose their moral authority and effectiveness for the future and find themselves on the wrong side of God and history.

14) By allowing a potentially illegitimate election to stand, many severe and devastatingly unintended consequences will occur, and could very well hit upon and undermine every aspect of life not only in America, but in the world as well.

15) To allow this comprehensive fraud to stand without exposing it is to court disaster, remove the blessing of God, and to essentially invite the same curse of illegitimacy on our land that has destroyed many nations when their politics are plagued by corruption.

16) It is an abject lie and pure nonsense that President Donald Trump incited violence of any kind, in any way, and at anytime on January 6th. Using the same standards that were used against him, it is rank hypocrisy for the Democrats and the media to speak of inciting violence when there are numerous actual examples of their speech having incited violence against the police, Republicans, and Trump supporters.

17) While the actual riotous activity at the Capitol is rightly condemned, the needed perspective is that what happened at the Capitol pales in comparison to what happens in other countries that get ripped in violence and discord from top to bottom when election fraud occurs or is strongly suspected to have occurred. And God forbid that we get pulled any further toward civil disunity because what happened at the Capitol will seem minor in comparison to what could happen, as history teaches us. Furthermore, what happened at the Capitol also doesn't come within a universe of the violence and anarchy committed by left wing mobs that was permitted to continue all summer long without denunciation from the same Democrats and media. Essentially, countries that are dominated by fraud are also countries that are dominated by oppression and violence.

18) It is impossible to make sense of the events at the Capitol without first making sense of the context in which those events took place. The extreme stress, pressure, and frustration that was experienced by tens of millions of Americans because of the evasiveness, censorship, and dysfunctionality in not addressing the obvious irregularities surrounding the entire spectacle of the election was that context in which the violence took place. And even in that, it must be noted that only a fraction of individuals were involved along with agent provocateurs who apparently incited the worst elements of it.

19) Using the terms "coup" and "insurrection" are pure word-cons that are only meant to distort reality, promote a false narrative, defame all "Trump supporters", and frame Trump in a phony impeachment. Actually, if there was any rigging of the election, that rigging would constitute a real "coup".

20) It is not good for the personal or spiritual health, or political legacy, of any leader to be silent on a matter of such importance as the presidential election. To leave any doubts in the minds of millions of Americans regarding the efficacy of the election is to only strengthen those doubts and create further division; and the longer the evasion continues, the greater the mistrust in our government agencies will become (which is now at historic highs).

21) Truth is relentless and God is not mocked. The truth about the presidential election is going to come out sooner or later.

22) Whenever there is an attempt to silence legitimate free speech, there is also an attempt to cover up some form of evil or wrongdoing, and the greater, more desperate, and more obvious the effort is to silence free speech, the greater is the evil or wrongdoing that is being covered up.

23) Many Republican leaders got completely outmaneuvered and intimidated into surrendering their voice and responsibility to speak out against the obvious election malfeasance. As a consequence, they lost the presidency and likely lost the Senate to the same type of fraud, as well as the trust of millions of members of their own base. Worse still, by siding with the "no evidence of election fraud" narrative, they essentially opened up those millions of good people to criticism and attacks as having supported a "conspiracy theory".

24) Violence and civil disunion are best mitigated through excellence and truth in governance, and through the encouragement of vigorous debate and the free flow of information.

25) The more imbalanced our nation becomes, the more lawless society will become; the more oppressive our politics will be, the less freedom and creativity we will have.

What Actually Happened

Millions of Americans, including the media and politicians from every background, know exactly what they saw with their own eyes before they went to bed the night of November 3rd and woke up to the next morning: President Trump's commanding lead in Georgia, Pennsylvania, Michigan, Wisconsin, etc., mysteriously vanished with no Republican poll watchers in attendance to verify that the votes were counted legitimately. This occurrence had all the signs of an alternate nefarious plan that involved simply waiting to see how many honest, true votes President Trump earned in those states in order to then determine how many votes were needed to be harvested from a bank of potentially hundreds of thousands of fake ballots, giving Joe Biden the lead once the fictitious votes were factored in.

Every mature, good and strong leader in the Senate needs to lead in this process. If this does not happen dramatically and soon, we will not have a country left that we will still be able to call America.

If we as a people are willing to do the hard work of restoring righteousness, goodness, and inspiration back to America, we will have saved our nation not only for ourselves, but also for future generations.
